



tunning pins



1/4, 2/4, 3/4 and 4/4 indicate the right pedal levels. Lines between the two line-system indicate the gradual change of the pedal-levels.

Note names in parenthesis, exp: [A0-A \flat 1], indicate which notes are held with the help of sostenuto pedal.


These indicate piano's inner areas

H

Primary voice: this voice with this symbol should be louder in the combination with the other voices, like %60 of whole sound.

N

Secondary voice: this voice should be quieter in the combination but present and strong enough.



Lines are indicating the metronom. The core metronoms are shown in the box above the system.

There are also metronoms are shown below the time signatures, which show the actual tempo in relation to the irrational time signatures.

Irrational time signatures are those which have a denominator that is not a power of two (1, 2, 4, 8, 16, 32, etc.). In this piece 10, 12 and 14 are used. For instance 5/12 means the whole note $\textcircled{5}$ is divided to 12 but only 5 of each parts are taken. $5 \times 1/12$. This can be understood as follows: denominator 10 is 2 large quintoles, 12 is two large sextoles and 14 is two large septoles. In the example, an eighth note in 6/8 bar becomes a eighth note of a large sextole. As an additional information, I gave the metronome mark below the time signatures.

Bar number 1:

Right hand plays with plectrum on the E2 string which is indicated in the system below. The system above shows the location of the right hand on the vertical position of the string. "regularly" means to play that noise regularly. 1b is an extra information which indicates the location area of the hand in the piano.

Right hand applies an over pressure, indicated with a overpressure sign on the system, with the bike-inner-tube on the given string in the system below, in this case on B3 string. Because of the pressure applied, it sounds intermittent. "IRregularly" indicates this character.

Bar number 1:

A book is placed before the performance in the middle of the strings on the A0 to A \flat 1 strings and it is used to dampen those strings. And left hand is playing the given notes. This should give percussive sound with the occasional 1st overtone because of the position of the book. \emptyset this sign is used for damping.

These are played inside the piano with a plectrum by plucking the given string. There are two kinds of plectrum. One is hard indicated with the black color and the other one is softer, indicated with green color.

The right hand is playing between two indicated strings with a tiny metal stick. Since those strings are also damped with the left hand on the same strings, one will hear the harmonics while changing the position of the metal stick vertically which are also shown between the upper systems graphically.
